Bus routes to Collegiate Crescent Campus

The 80 bus is a dedicated service linking both universities and Collegiate Crescent Campus. It can be caught on Arundel Gate (marked on map) and goes via Ecclesall Road, Hunters Bar and then back to City Campus.

For those visiting the Ecclesall Road end of the campus take the 81, 82, 83, 85 or 86 from Leopold Street, outside the Zavvi Megastore (marked on map). For those visiting the Clarkehouse Road end of the campus take the 30 from Church Street (marked on map).

The 60 (Crimicar Lane) from the Transport Interchange will take visitors to the Royal Hallamshire Hospital which is a short walk from Clarkehouse Road.

The route to City Campus

The direction numbers relate to the central Sheffield map above.

From junction 33 of the M1, follow signs for A630 Sheffield City Centre. Continue on the A630 until the dual carriageway ends at a large roundabout with traffic signals (Park Square) 1. Take the fourth exit from the roundabout signposted Hallam University, then take the third left into Arundel Gate, signposted Hallam University 2. Follow this road until the next roundabout, (Furnival Square) 3. Take the first left, then the second left onto Arundel Street. The entrance to City Campus is straight ahead.

There is limited on-street pay and display parking on Arundel Street and a NCP car park on Arundel Gate and Eyre Street, and next to the railway station.

The route to Collegiate Crescent Campus

The direction numbers relate to the central Sheffield map above

From junction 33 of the M1, follow signs for A630 Sheffield City Centre. Continue on the A630 until the dual carriageway ends at a large roundabout with traffic signals (Park Square) 1. Take the third exit from the roundabout signposted A61 Chesterfield. Go straight ahead following the road in front of the railway station 2. Take the middle lane signed A61 Ring Road. Follow the road to the right onto St. Mary's Road 3. Travel straight ahead. At Moor Street roundabout turn left signposted A625 Castleton onto Ecclesall Road 4. Collegiate Crescent is approximately 750 metres (1/2 mile) along on the right shortly after the Renault

There is very limited street parking in these areas.

Central Sheffield

Our location

Sheffield Hallam University is based in the heart of the country in Britain's fifth largest city. Major road and rail networks link Sheffield directly with the rest of the country and the city itself is served by excellent bus and supertram services. Our City Campus is directly adjacent to Sheffield's central Transport Interchange at Pond Street, and is a two minute walk from Sheffield Railway Station. There is a taxi rank outside the railway station. The journey time to Collegiate Crescent is 10-15 minutes.

Rail links

Regular inter-city services operate between Sheffield and other major towns and cities. The London journey takes around two and a half hours, Manchester and Leeds are about an hour away and Birmingham is about an hour and 20 mins away.

Road links

Sheffield is easily accessible by road with a dual carriageway link (A630) from junction 33 on the M1 directly to the city centre.

NB. There are currently major ongoing roadworks around the city centre. Please be aware that there may be diversions in place.

Car parking

Disabled visitors are advised to phone before visiting so suitable parking can be arranged.


There is restricted parking on all campuses. Visitors are advised to use NCP or other pay and display parking where available.
